Report from the Chairman and Executive Director

Help Us Help Our Kids

We would like to thank all of you—our remarkable donors and volunteers—for your loyalty and continued dedicated support of our Northwest Federal Credit Union Foundation. We would also like to thank our Board of Directors and Northwest Federal Credit Union employees for their ongoing passionate efforts to ensure that our organization continues to make a difference in the lives of those we help now and in the future.

Thanks to the contributions of many talented volunteers and the support of you—our donors—there is much progress to report in 2013, a breakthrough year for our Foundation. In order to meet our goal to build an organization that will survive and thrive for generations of members to come, we added \$180,000 to our endowment fund bringing our total to date to over \$344,000. By adding to this fund in future years we will continue to strengthen our financial footing.

While preparing for the future, we continued to contribute and strengthen our community daily through our scholarship, mentoring and youth outreach programs. In 2013 we awarded twenty Ben DeFelice scholarships totaling \$100,000 and our charitable contributions totaled over \$38,000 to help our communities in countless ways locally, including over \$11,000 to Children's Miracle Network to benefit our regional Children's National Medical Center in Washington, DC. In partnership with Northwest Federal Credit Union, we extended disaster recovery aid to our global neighbors in the Philippines through a \$10,453 donation to Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières in the wake of the devastation of Typhoon Haiyan.

Together we donated thousands of volunteer hours and raised money to benefit technology initiatives and staff development for local schools. Through our holiday food, toy, coat and Adopt a Family drives we delivered the magic of the season to local families through organizations like Northern Virginia Family Service and LINK, Inc. We continued to mentor students and fund a program at Dranesville Elementary in Herndon, VA to provide backpacks of food every weekend for students who otherwise might not have reliable access to food

outside of school—about 24% of the student body. Our employees delivered over 300 meals through our local Meals On Wheels program to senior citizens and adults with disabilities who cannot shop for or prepare their own meals.

In partnership with Inova Children's Hospital in Fairfax, VA we presented our Fourth Annual Night of Magic, an evening like no other for children battling chronic and sometimes life-threatening illnesses and their families. This is a magical night of dance, entertainment, dining, games and prizes that helps to take them away from their daily fears and worries. This is always one of our most memorable and rewarding events, one that our guests look forward to every year.

The year 2013 was another remarkable year, thanks to you, and once again proved that we work together better than we do individually.

We hope that we can count on you to continue to *Help Us Help Our Kids* in the years ahead.
