2014 was another great year for our Foundation and the children and families we serve. We wish to thank you, our generous donors for your consistent and heart-felt support. Many of you have given annually since 2004!

On this, our tenth anniversary, we are grateful for your encouragement and support. Regardless of the cause or program, you have responded in the true spirit of charitable giving.

Our ten-year record:

- Awarded 146 Ben DeFelice Scholarships totaling \$654,000
- Granted over \$143,580 to our partner schools
- Donated over \$235,020 to other charitable organizations, including Children's Miracle Network Hospitals, Special Olympics Virginia and Homes for Our Troops
- Taught over 27,250 students the importance of saving, spending and sharing money wisely
- Hosted over 650 young patients at Children's National Medical Center and Inova Fairfax Hospital and their families at our annual Night of Magic Balls
- Coordinated over 2,064 volunteers donating 8,164 hours
- Organized almost 100 food, toy, blood, clothing and school supply drives to assist local families in need

New in 2014:

- Donated nearly ten tons of food and \$7,500 to our first Summertime Food Drive for LINK, Inc.
- Coordinated a Salvation Army Angel Tree program to provide toys to 38 youngsters
- Donated \$9,033 to Children's Miracle Network Hospitals for Credit Union Miracle Day and participated in the Credit Union Cherry Blossom Ten Mile Run with the largest race team of 99 employees and 50 volunteers
